Bruce Ashback passed away Friday, June 4, 2021. Born to Agnes and Eugene Ashback in Spokane, he spent most of his life in the Portland metro area. After graduating from Grant High School, he served in Vietnam, returning to Oregon in 1971. With his uncle, Gary Ashback, he owned and operated Ashback Construction in Bend, OR. When he moved back to Portland, he became a union carpenter.

Most recently before his retirement he was a business agent for the carpenters union. He served on several committees and mentored many as they came through the ranks. He was an avid supporter of combat veterans entering the construction trades and started a scholarship to assist them in 2015.

In 1992, he married Carrie. In 2001, they bought a house that Bruce would spend much of his time in retirement fixing up. He loved listening to his daughter play piano, sitting on the back porch with Carrie, and playing with his grand dog, Pepper.

Bruce was preceded in death by his parents, Eugene and Agnes; younger brother, Dale; and uncle, Gary. He is survived by his wife, Carrie; daughter, Sara; stepson, Jess; youngest brother, Paul (Debbie); and several nieces and nephews.
