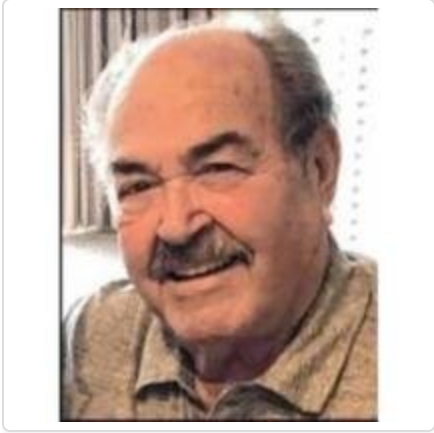




Daniel John Dillon
