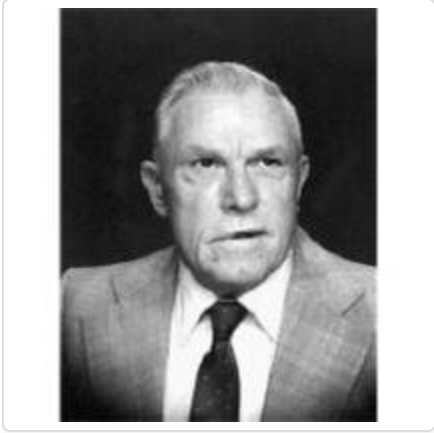




Gerald G. Thompson

Gerald Gene Thompson of Vancouver, WA, passed away on August 21, 2009 at the age of 87. He was born on Nov. 27, 1921 in Van Wert, Iowa to Raymond and Esther (McGahuey) Thompson. He is survived by his wife of 65 years, Ora Jean Thompson. They were married in the Bremerton Navy Chapel Dec. 15, 1944.
