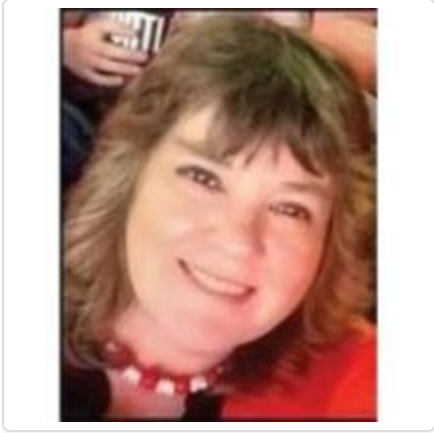




Janet B Steinmueller
