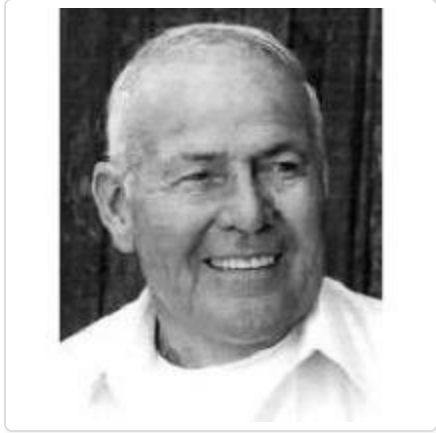




Roger William Rustrum
