WILLIAM "WILL" EDMUND BOCKERT KRAJEWSKI March 27, 1999 ~ August 22, 2016 William Edmund Bockert Krajewski passed away at home in Salmon Creek on Monday August 22 from osteosarcoma (a form of bone cancer) that had spread to his lungs. Will was born in Warwick, Rhode Island on March 27, 1999 to Joe and Karen Krajewski. Will is survived by his parents, numerous uncles and aunts and twelve cousins. Will was entering his senior year at Prairie High School in Battle Ground where he was an honor student. He achieved the rank of Eagle Scout as a member of Troop 310 of the Cascade Pacific Council of the Boy Scouts of America in June. He was a Brotherhood member of the Order of the Arrow, the Boy Scout Honor Society. Will was a member of St. Andrew Lutheran Church, Vancouver, WA where he was confirmed. Will was baptized at Pilgrim Lutheran Church in Warwick, Rhode Island in April, 1999. He lived in Glocester, Rhode Island until moving to Salmon Creek in 2007 with his parents. Weeks before being diagnosed with osteosarcoma, Will ran Leg 12 (The Anchorman) of the Hood To Coast relay in 2012 at the age of 13; one of the youngest runners ever. Will enjoyed supporting numerous charities including the Boy Scouts, NW Sarcoma, Ronald McDonald House Charities, Raphael House, the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society and the Providence Cancer Center. A Memorial Service will be held Saturday, September 17, 2016 at 11:00 AM, St. Andrew Lutheran Church, Vancouver, Washington. A time of fellowship and food will follow the service.
